

# **Direct Hunger Relief**

## **Meet Dr. Salinas**

Homebound seniors and disabled adults can be particularly vulnerable to hunger due to health and mobility issues. That's why we deliver groceries to these neighbors in Oak Park, River Forest, and a portion of Austin. In addition to hunger relief, these visits offer a critical social connection, helping offset the loneliness and social isolation too common for this population.

Those connections are also important to Adriana Riano, Beyond Hunger's Program Manager. "I was initially the main person calling clients to get their food choices every month. Talking to Dr. Salinas was one of my most dreaded tasks back then. I didn't understand why he was always unhappy with our food options, because I thought they were pretty good. I explained repeatedly that we were limited to the food available at the local food bank. Providing items like 'chorizo' or 'crunchy peanut butter was out of our control."

"One day Dr. Salinas asked me, 'Adriana, do you like arroz con pollo?' I quickly replied, 'Yes, I love it!' He laughed and proceeded to invite me to his home to have a meal with him. While I was not able to share a meal with him, that invitation alone changed everything. Since then I have learned many things about Dr. Salinas. For example, he lives alone and doesn't have any family that live close by. Now, I understand that Dr. Salinas just wants someone to talk to. When he calls, we joke around, he gives me a hard time, and I enjoy every minute of it. He's a big part of why I am passionate about this work."

## **Meet Wafaa**

We know you can't end hunger simply with a bag of groceries. Research shows that providing education on nutrition and cooking markedly enhances food security for a whole family. Just ask Wafaa. As she was shopping at the Food Pantry last year, Wafaa learned about the opportunity to participate in a cooking class. She signed up, and her life--and her children's lives--changed for the better.

During her first day in the cooking class, Wafaa received a test that showed her blood sugars fell into the elevated zone. Surprised at the result, she followed up with her physician. She learned she was prediabetic, that her cholesterol was high, and that she was anemic. Determined to improve her conditions, Wafaa took every opportunity presented at Beyond Hunger to learn more. "The dietitians at the Food Pantry helped me a lot" she said. "They taught me a lot about how you cook, how you change from unhealthy food to healthy food." Wafaa took the lessons to heart. And today, her blood sugar and cholesterol numbers are all within normal limits. She is no longer anemic and has more energy for her six kids.

## **Of Trade Wars and Freezers**

You wouldn't think a food pantry had much to do with international trade. But this year the trade war with China and steep tariffs have resulted in a glut of pork in the domestic market. To ameliorate the potential devastation to U.S. farmers, the administration has created a \$12 billion bailout program, with the USDA purchasing an additional \$1.3 million worth of pork for nutrition assistance programs. As a result, tons of pork (literally!) are flooding our food pantry freezers.

Why is that a problem? Space limits healthy options. With our limited freezer capacity, pork elbows out other options like fish or chicken. We are stocking more canned products, but canned chicken doesn't stretch as far as a roaster. Of course, there are non-meat products and people are still grateful for all the food we provide. But we'll all be glad when we can offer more variety again.



## **Waste Not**

Volunteers are critical to every aspect of Beyond Hunger, clocking on average 2,000 hours every month. Every volunteer, including those in less public roles, is helping to end hunger in our communities. And some of them are helping sustain our environment as well.

Thomas Schouten, who has been volunteering for 11 years, does both. Each week, Thom drives to local grocery stores that are part of our Food Rescue program. Food that has not been purchased, and is at risk of being wasted, is removed from grocery stores and brought to the Food Pantry where it is sorted for freshness. Inedible food gets composted. The work may not be glamorous, but it is deeply satisfying—and impactful. Last year over 113,000 pounds of food made its way to people in need instead of into the waste stream.

For Thom, volunteering has layers of meaning. "It doesn't feel like work," he said. "There hasn't been a day when I didn't want to come to volunteer. I have always felt so valued by the staff. And I know I am doing something in my community for my community. There are a lot of hungry people for whom the Food Pantry plays a vital role. We should all be aware of that."




## **Rescue Partners**

# **Hunger Free Communities**


How can a community be hunger free? By working together to identify need, coordinate resources, and bolster political will for collaborative action, we can build a community where everyone has access to the food they need. Sometimes that's as simple as helping someone with a complicated benefits application or finding out how one slipped through the bureaucratic cracks.

Henry, an 86-year-old Oak Park veteran, is a proud man who likes to do things on his own. But the process to renew his CTA Ride Free Permit had him stumped. So, when he was referred to Amanda Kuhn, our Social Services Coordinator, he accepted. Finding Amanda kind and helpful, Henry also mentioned that he had applied for SNAP on his own six months earlier but had never heard back. Amanda was able to log into the application database to check his status and found that he had been approved and had \$250 worth of benefits waiting for him. With supplemental food and mobility access, Henry feels like he's regained his independence.

## **Coalition Building • Advocacy • Financial Literacy • Social Services**

Many of those we serve are on special diets that can make living on a fixed food budget even more difficult. It's one of the many reasons Amanda is diligent about trouble-shooting SNAP application problems, and why she is delighted when she can help someone like Melvin.

Like Henry, Melvin had applied for SNAP on his own. He'd been successful in his initial application, but the renewal was not coming through. Amanda contacted DHS, which processed his case on the spot, reinstating his SNAP benefits immediately, including \$1,059 in SNAP benefits that were waiting for him. When Amanda gave Melvin the good news, he exclaimed "Holy Shoot!" (Seriously, no swears. Melvin is a gentleman.) Melvin was overjoyed that he and his wife would now be able to purchase the special foods her diet requires.





# **Training to See**

The Board of Directors has been working to ensure that Beyond Hunger has the advantage of varied perspectives to help serve our entire community.

"We need multiple perspectives to richly understand the needs of our community," affirms Stephanie Schrodt, Board Vice-President. "Blind spots created by a lack of racial and ethnic diversity can be particularly concerning, as they may result in strategies and plans that ineffectively address societal challenges and inequities, or even reinforce them."

One strategy arising out of this work is the establishment of a client task force engaged in a wholesale evaluation of the Food Pantry program. Program participants are now an integral part of the team creating and implementing assessment protocols that will enhance programs. "I guess we're in the best position to know what's working and what's not," said one task force member. "It feels great to be part of making it better for everyone."


